Luana Gibbs, Health Director for Hyde County announces Hyde County's second laboratory confirmed case of COVID-19. The individual is in isolation at home and close contacts have been identified and are quarantined as well. Though we have been fortunate to have a very small number of laboratory confirmed cases, we must not become complacent, as COVID-19 remains an extremely contagious virus. Gibbs reminds the public to implement and continue your 3 Ws practices:

If you leave home, know your Ws!
